Cars parked illegally (facing wrong direction, obstructing driveway, inhibiting access of emergency vehicles, too close to corner, stop sign, or fire hydrant, and other as prescribed by law)	No Authority		May ticket or tow as allowed per law. Car parked in front of my house	No Authority		No Authority	Savannah Streets are public streets.

Inoperable or unregistered vehicle in driveway or on street	May violate/ fine. May refer vehicle on street to police for tow; may tow from driveway.
