


## WEATHER SAFETY



Patron and employee safety should never be put at risk. If a storm or other bad weather is predicted, stay alert for signs of the coming storm, such as thunder, lightning, or high winds.

The National Lightning Safety
Institute recommends waiting 30
minutes after the last lightning
sighting or sound of thunder
before resuming activities. All
patrons must vacate the facility
until it is safe to reopen.

During a thunderstorm, patrons and staff must remain out of showers and locker rooms as water and metal can conduct electricity.
